

On June 19th, Bridgewater will be having a 2.8 million dollar override vote. If this override fails, here is how the town will be affected:

\*Public Library will close

\*Senior Center will close

\*Recreation Department will close

\*Police – Reduction of 13 officers

\*Fire – Reduction of 20 of firefighters

Although this vote does not affect the schools directly, as teachers, we need to stand united with all town departments to ensure this vote passes. It is time to show all residents that we are NOT a town divided - it is NOT town vs. school - we are all in this together.
